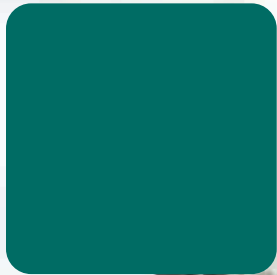

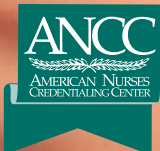

Cancellation Policy: If you cannot attend the workshop, you will be entitled to a refund according to the following schedule:

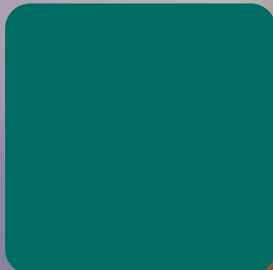
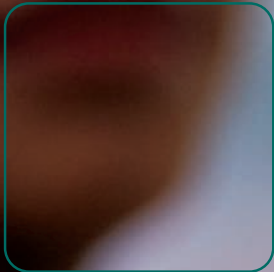
